1 Welcome and introductions

After the welcome and presentations, the chair Danielle Mincio remainded the procedure of the discussion in the SC. The members of the SC have the priority in the discussions. The observers have the possibility to give their opinion after the SC members and with the approval of the chair.

Short considerations have been done about 2011 year activity in San Juan Puerto Rico.

4 Feedback on the situation in Northern Italy after the May 2012 Earthquake

The Secretary Ornella Foglieni, as agreed with the Chair, has shown a Power Point presentation of 11 minutes, as feed back of the situation in Northern Italy after the Earthquake about damaged libraries. The same, but just for five minutes, shall be allowed to replay also to the session on 16th Aug, as starter.

5. Report of the Chair

The chair Mincio, referred about the 5 IFLA Key initiatives in particular on Key Initiative 4 (KI4) *Cultural Heritage Disaster Reconstruction Programme: Culture is a basic need, a culture thrives through its cultural heritage.*

She has been given information about the financed Project of the section concerning the World Map of risk. This project is strategic for IFLA and in direct link with the KI4. The focused discussion on it with details will be scheduled in the SC II meeting.

A restrict group of SC interested members meanwhile will met Mr Bothma, author of the IFLA World Map on line together with other technicians. The project first step is for this year is to improve and test a questionnaire on specific data concerning natural and human disasters and the way to front them.

Mincio underlined the importance of the preparedness and of the training and referred about a satellite meeting held in Lausanne concerning the rescue of the collection. It would be useful to organize at least one meeting also in Singapore on this topic. Also with Milan (Italy) the relationship has been kept .(seminar on 3th March) has been organized on the disasters .

8. Report from the SIG Environmental sustainability and libraries

The Chair of SIG -Special Interest Group Environmental sustainability and libraries summarized their actions.

Co Convenor Vincent Bonnet has stepped down from Co-Convenor activities, being replaced at the SIG's Business Meeting in SJPR by co-convenors Leila Sonkkanen and Philippe Colomb, with Harri Sahavirta as back-up. Veerle Minner continues for another term as convenor. Membership in mailing lists increased. The ENSULIB SIG was presented by Veerle Minner at two professional meetings in Spain. Paper selection procedures for the Open Session are being constantly further refined and a selection committee was created. SI was obtained for the Open Session in San Juan, where attendants numbered over 100. The Internationalization objective of the group was fulfilled in S, Juan and will also be in Helsinki, where extra off-site ENSULIB events have been scheduled besides the Open Session.

9. Future Programme (Singapore)

Arthur Tennoe, Philippe Vallas, and others prepare for the 2nd SC a proposal for a 4 hours joint session with IT, Rare Books, PC sections on the theme Integrating physical and digital preservation.

10. Future satellite meeting (Singapore)

The two guests, Mr. Chang and his colleague of Singapore declared their availability and desire to prepare a seminar on next year pre - Conference in Singapore area for the next 2013. the theme will be around the disaster rescue and preparedness with an accent on the specific needs in Asia (support, climate specificities). This program will be managed by Danielle Mincio and Ornella Foglieni.

14 New projects

Mincio asked all members to suggest new initiatives. Jeanne Drewes look for the possibility to make a project on the preservation for the needs of the library users with the Public Library Section. (How to provide information to the public on protecting and preserving their family treasures from disaster. This would fit well with your focus but would be information to the public.).

16. AOB – Program and satellite meeting for WLIC 2014 in Europe

Possibility to held a satellite meeting in Lausanne, Milan or in France. Discussion on the need to know at the begin of the WLIC the name of the city who is elected for the WLIC in 2 years.
