ARL has a diverse global membership now that we have two new co-opted members from Asia. The number of ARL Facebook followers keep increasing. There are over 5600 followers as of September 2022. Our webinars are very popular globally.

Many of our activities take place on an ongoing basis, eg. blogs, webinars, Travel Grant and so on. We usually review, improve and enhance these activities regularly, as new members take the coordination role and new ideas are suggested. They are not static, but evolve on a continuous basis.
