With the IFLA Green Library Award we support the work of professionals worldwide, with criteria on how to design and implement sustainability standards that contribute to the effective delivery of library services and missions.

ACTIVITIES:

Development of the Award description, criteria and announcement details

The introduction texts (description & definitions) and the criteria are reconsidered, updated, and thereafter published on ENSULIB’s web page. The aim is a rigorous definition and description of the Green and Sustainable Library, which would substitute previous (outdated) ones as a point of reference. The criteria for Award submissions are clarified.

The work will be done autumn 2021 by the SC subcommittee “ENSULIB project ‘Award 2022’”, led by Harri Sahavirta, and published early 2022 by Priscilla Pun

Submission management, the evaluation of the submissions, and selection of the winners

Call for submissions, early 2022, deadline in February

Petra Hauke will prepare the CfP and the submissions are to be send to her. Harri Sahavirta will coordinate the evaluation process.

March 2022, the long list of submissions is published

April 2022, the short list of submissions is published

The winners are announced in the Award Session in WLIC 2022
