- 4. Approved minutes of previous meeting on 3 August.
- 5. Report on workshops 1 &2- good attendance, interest in the committee and what we dothanks to Cristina and Jennifer for all their work on the webinars
- 6. New structure of section- Abeer needed to leave the committee and her assignment as the Information Coordinator, our section needs to find a new information coordinator, an email was sent out from me asking for a volunteer and instructions, we have 10 days to find a new IC.
- 7. Review of annual report- reviewed and submitted to Division A chair after meeting.
- 8. Review of Action plan- doing well with webinars. Need to improve with gathering additional local history and genealogy resources. Laila suggested a subcommittee to work on this. Jingzhu suggested the open access tracking project (OATP), which is a collaborative effort to track new OA developments worldwide.
