Draft Minutes

Present:

Meeting 1

1. Welcome and introduction.
Patrice welcome the Committee members and everyone introduced themselves
2. Agenda.
The agenda was approved with the following additions in 8 (Any other business):
 - Future of ICBC
 - Access to meetings of the Committee (observers)
3. Matters arising since the last meetings (as of July 31).
 - 3.1 Reports to GB (April / August).
The Chair submitted two reports to the Governing Board in 2012.
 - 3.2 IFLA Repository Project.
The Chair informed the Committee that he had been invited to attend the presentations of the two vendors retained by the GB committee during the Helsinki conference. He will ensure that issues relating to the access and maintenance of IFLA standards in the repository will be addressed by the vendors.
 - 3.3 ISO TC 46 Representative.
There are still some questions relating to the role of Paola Manoni (and the role IFLA has on the ISO TC 46). It is not clear if she indeed reports only to Division III Library services. Also, the Committee will need to determine if she reports also to the Committee on Standards. Joanne will investigate this issue.
 - 3.4 Universal Bibliographic Control (UBC) Statement.
The Bibliography section will be issuing a UBC statement probably after the Helsinki Conference and asked how and who should be endorsing the statement. The Chair suggested that this matter be discussed during the Helsinki Conference.
 - 3.5 FRBR question on using non IFLA domain names.
The FRBR group discussed the possibility of using the www.frbr.org domain which has become freely available. Advice was given that this issue be referred to the PC and to IFLA HQ. in case the FRBR group would decide to use it.
 - 3.6 Other matters arising
 - 3.6.1 Open Access for IFLA standards.

This issue was brought to the attention of the Committee by Mirna Willer who asked what was the status of the work in making IFLA publications open access. Ingeborg Verheul responded to her by explaining the work IFLA is pursuing. Alan Hopkinson also indicated his concerns relating to access to the UNIMARC manual. Jennefer Nicholson is involved in ongoing negotiations with De Gruyter and the committee will be updated on this.

3.6.2 Visibility of IFLA's Standards.

Promotion and financing of standards work needs attention. Issue will come up in general discussion during congress (Officers Training, Leadership brief, SC meetings, etc)

4 Audit of IFLA standards – status report.

Some Sections have still not responded but majority are there. List is currently in pdf form; it will be a good base for filling the new IFLA repository in 2013 when it might need to be updated and more things might need to be done with it. The Chair circulated a sub-list extracted from the full list that identified ongoing, or planned, revisions.

5 IFLA Namespaces Technical Group.

Ambiguity exists about where it resides and who it reports to. Simon Lemstra at IFLA HQ is in contact to discuss link to HQ IT Section. It has links to several Sections: Cataloguing (plus working groups on ISBD etc), Bibliography, and Classification and Indexing. Standards Committee should advise on its reporting structure.

6 Work plan for 2012-13 (issues).

This item held over until second meeting.

7 Activities of the Committee during Helsinki.

7.1 Open session (Thursday August 16, 10.45 – 12.45).

Gordon Dunsire, Coordinator of the Namespaces TG will speak for ten minutes then the Chair will focus on discussion and issues:

- 1) What is an IFLA Standard
- 2) Procedures for initiating, validating, reviewing, eliminating.
- 3) Presentation format
- 4) Open Access
- 5) Safeguarding and archiving
- 6) Namespaces
- 7) Semantic world
- 8) New standards and updates
- 9) Endorsement and the role of the Standards Committee.

This will feed into discussion about priorities for 2012-13. Might also need to discuss whether working groups with wider participation will be needed.

Discussion about the role of Division representatives on the Standards Committee and their links with the Divisions which might need support. The Committee should identify what needs doing, advise the GB about this, and recommend how it can be done. Need to standardize the processes for IFLA standards, rather than work directly on any of the standards.

- 7.2 Second SC meeting (Thursday August 16, 14.00 – 15.00).
Focus on the workplan (see minutes of second SC meeting below).
- 8 Any other business.
- 8.1 ICBC.
Important that the Professional Committee addresses the question of its future/replacement as this was where IFLA standards news was reported. The Standards Committee has an interest in the outcome, as does UNIMARC and also a number of Sections.
- 8.2 Access to Standards Committee meetings.
A number of people not on the Committee asked if they could attend. As the existence of the rules governing this question were not known by the Chair, the people were not granted access. Joanne will check the relevant rules and inform the Chair for future meetings.

Meeting 2

The discussion was focused on item 6 from above.

Discussion started on the definition of IFLA standards and whether this should be the primary task for the Committee. The Chair confirmed that, with input from the professional units of IFLA, the Committee should propose to the Governing Board what it considered as IFLA standards, and therefore, what role the Committee would have in their management.

ISO definitions and procedures might help guide the Committee in its early stages, though it was recognized that some aspects might not apply to IFLA (eg country representation and voting). Françoise offered to share these with the Committee.

The Chair suggested that it would also be useful to survey the IFLA units on their opinion on the definition of an IFLA standard, and to know what the procedures currently are for arriving at a consensus agreement on a standard.

Françoise mentioned that with ISO, a regular review process included the step of assessing adoption by the community and if the standard in question had not been adopted after several reviews, it was be withdrawn.

Alan asked if a template for standards meant a template for the contents, or a template for the procedures. The former might also be useful but it should become clearer if this was possible, and what it might look like, once a definition is in place and the related procedures are understood.

Alan agreed to try to find out what the British Computer Society did to validate standards and see whether this would be useful. He suggested it might be useful to find out what other national or international bodies did.

The Chair confirmed with the Committee that the definition of an IFLA standard and the procedures governing them should be the priority for next year. It might be possible to have this ready for the December GB meeting. In any case, the real deadline would be to have something ready for discussion with the units at the WLIC 2013 in August 2013.

Some progress could be made by email but a Skype call could be scheduled, possibly for November.

Any Other Business

The role of the Committee's Division Representatives in relation to the divisions was not defined in the terms of reference for the Committee. This needs some thought and development. They should be invited to the Leadership Forum and Division Forums during congress, and also included in communications from the Division Chairs. Joanne will follow up on this.

The Committee agreed that no updates to existing standards should be delayed pending discussions of the Committee.

Anders raised the problem of access to existing versions of published standards (in the red back series). This is something that the Secretary General is aware of and is following up in discussions with the publisher. There is also the question raised during the audit of whether a more flexible, and more fluid, online platform might be better for some publications and the Committee might need to think about that at some stage.

Questions about the members' terms on the Committee: this nomination process is typical for GB-appointed committees. The member is nominated and appointed in an individual capacity and so does not need to stand down if they cease to be a member of another standing committee for example. Members have been appointed for two years, and can be reappointed for a second consecutive term (August 2013 – 2015).

Report from ISO TC46 – Information and documentation - annual meeting

Berlin, May 5nd – 8th 2012

TC46 on Information and documentation has been leading efforts related to information management since 1947. Standards developed under ISO/TC 46 facilitate access to knowledge and information and standardize automated tools, computer systems, and services relating to its major stakeholders of: libraries, publishing, documentation and information centres, archives, records management, museums, indexing and abstracting services, and information technology suppliers to these communities. TC46 has a unique role among ISO information-related committees in that it focuses on the whole lifecycle of information from its creation and identification, through delivery, management, measurement, and archiving, to final disposition.

Annual meeting

The following report summarizes the key-topics emerged during the week in Berlin - with particular regards to the discussions held in the meetings of SC4, S8 SC9¹ and plenary TC46 - of probable interest to the IFLA community.

1. Standardization of ePub 3.0

SC4 has established a working group to profile ePub version 3.0, especially keeping in mind the concerns of long-term preservation.

The SC4 chair will contact the IDPF² executive director, Bill McCoy, for discussions.

TC 46 acknowledges the need to standardize the ePub version 3.0 as developed by IDPF;

TC 46 further recognizes the need of the Information and documentation community to develop ISO documents referring to a standardized ePub version 3.0.

TC 46 therefore expresses readiness to lead a fast-track acceptance of the ePub version 3.0, pending agreement from IDPF. Potential offers from other International (ISO, IEC) standardization groups to coordinate in order to attain the goal of an expeditious standardization of ePub version 3.0 will be considered with high interest.

ePub is a distribution and interchange format standard for digital publications and documents. It defines a means of representing, packaging and encoding structured and semantically enhanced Web content for distribution in a single-file format.

2. Revision of ISO 25577: MarcXChange

SC4 approves the revision for ISO 25577. This standard describes a generalized MARCXML schema that is useable for all records using the ISO 2709 syntax without changing the structure and with as few changes as possible to the original schema. This schema provides a specification for the development of local simple schemas, ensuring compatibility.

The main purpose is to include embedded fields, which is a specific request from users of UNIMARC.

SC4 acknowledges an *ad hoc group* has met and considered a draft amendment to ISO 25577 prepared by Danish Standards and recommends member bodies consider adopting the completed draft for submission as a DIS (Draft International Standard). The balloting of this draft will be closed on January 2013.

3. ISO 28560: RFID in libraries: new work items

SC4 approves to initiate a ballot for two new technical specifications:

1. Rules for ISO 28560-1 data elements to be encoded in radio frequency identification (RFID) tags with a memory structure that is partitioned into four memory banks (e.g. ISO/IEC 18000-6 Type C operating in the UHF frequency, but not necessarily restricted to this technology) - (Proposer: United Kingdom);
2. Encoding method used to form the unique item identifier (UII) of RFID tag where a tag supports different memory areas for the UII and other Item-related data (e.g. ISO/IEC 18000-6 type C, type D and ISO/IEC 18000-3 MODE 3), and when the UII is assigned for a library application - (Proposer: Japan).

4. SC4 on ILL

The Interlibrary Loan (ILL) Application Protocol was devised to allow the automatic exchange of ILL requests and responses from system to system. In creating the standards, the library community and the vendors that serve this community agreed on a common structure for ILL request transactions. The standards describe each type of message that may be involved in the ILL request process; the data that may be included in each message; the sequence in which the messages may be received; and the syntax of the messages.

These standards enabled ILL to take advantage of the electronic communications methods available at the time of their development and thereby to become a highly efficient process. They also allowed a variety of software vendors to develop systems with the promise that their clients would be able to communicate with other institutions.

SC4 asks ILL/Maintenance Agency to review ISO 10160 and 10161 to address known defects and propose a revision before the end of August 2012.

SC4 invites Danish Standards to prepare a new work item in cooperation with other interested parties, for a new ILL standard before the end of October 2012.

SC4 asks the chair of SC4 to establish a WG to develop a new ILL standard, if NWIP is approved.

SC4 asks the chair to convene a group of experts in resource sharing to develop a road map for content delivery in general, of which ILL is a part.

5. ISO 639 Codes for the representation of names of languages

SC4 notes with concern the actions of ISO/TC 37/SC 2 to revise the family of ISO 639 standards. As ISO 639 is a joint project with TC 46, SC4 would like to highlight the stability of the multi-part standard and its preference that it not be impacted by the planned merger into a single standard. SC4 secretariat will contact TC37/SC 2 to discuss a positive solution in this work.

TC 46 shares the concern of SC 4 about a revision of the ISO 639 - standards series as this was unilaterally decided by TC 37/SC 2. Governance of the ISO 639 standards series is shared between TC 37/SC 2 and SC 4 in accordance with ISO 639-4. TC 46 supports SC 4 in its endeavors to find a solution to this situation.

6. Support on the work of NISO

SC4 supports the work of NISO to organize a meeting of metadata communities and encourages NISO to report the outcomes of its work to SC4 to serve as a possible basis for future SC4 standards work.

7. DCMI³ / SC4

SC4 invites DCMI, as a category A Liaison⁴, to consider proposing DCMI standards as ISO standards.

8. Imminent publication of standards (under the responsibility of SC9, see appendix I)

ISO 26324 (DOI) - This approved standard, has been a US National standard for years and a *de facto* standard since 2000 that provides persistent identification for e-content, including e-books.

ISO 27730 (ISCI). This approved standard, specifies an identifier as a unique international identification system for each collection and fond.

ISO 27729 (ISNI). This approved standard, specifies an identifier for public identities of parties involved throughout the media content industries in the creation, production, management, and content distribution chains.

9. Ad Hoc Identifiers Integrity Group

SC9 reappoints the convener of the *Ad Hoc Identifiers Integrity Group* and revises its mandate as follows:

- To monitor problems with the issuance, by parties that are not authorized by ISO Registration Authorities, of identifiers appearing to be ISO identifiers;
- To consider approaches that might mitigate these problems;
- To convene a meeting of the group during the plenary week in 2013.

10. *Ad Hoc Identifier Interoperability working group*

SC9 notes that its *Ad Hoc Identifier Interoperability working group* is seeking to define the semantic representation of the relationship between its identifiers. SC9 has identified the Linked Content Coalition⁵ as a forum with the required expertise to define and maintain such semantic representations, and which is understood to be willing to carry out this work.

11. Other revisions of standards

- Under the responsibility of TC46:
 - ISO 7098: "Romanization of Chinese";
 - ISO 3602 "Romanization of Japanese (kana script)";
 - TC 46 calls for its members to put forward experts to participate in the revision of ISO 11799. "Document storage requirements for archive and library materials".
- Under the responsibility of SC8:
 - ISO/TR 14873 "Statistics and quality issues for web archiving";
 - ISO 16439 "Information and documentation – Methods and procedures for assessing the impact of libraries".
- Under the responsibility of SC9:
 - ISO 15707: "International Standard Musical Work Code (ISWC)".

12. Reactivation of SC10

TC46 requests DIN (Deutsches Institut für Normung) to draft the scope and justification to reactivate SC10 Physical Keeping of Documents. Thereafter, ISO TC 46 instructs its secretariat to initiate a ballot to determine the willingness of TC46 to reactivate SC 10.
