Approved Minutes. Management & Marketing Standing Committee. Business Meeting II

- 1. Opening of the meeting (including approving the agenda, regrets) (Nick)
 - a. Agenda approved.
- 2. Approving last meeting's minutes (Jeannie)
 - a. Minutes approved with no changes.
- 3. Welcome new and continuing members (round of introductions) (Nick)
 - a. New and continuing members introduced themselves, with a wide range of libraries and experience/positions/roles represented.
 - b. We currently have 19 members.
 - Looking into co-opting one more member from a region that is geographically underrepresented. **Action:** share information about the co-opting process on our Basecamp site.
- 4. Courtesies/procedures of serving on the Standing Committee (Nick)
 - a. Please be flexible re: meeting time when filling out the Doodle poll as we have members located in practically every region.
 - b. If you cannot make the meeting, **please notify one of the officers** to alert them that you will not be present.
- 5. Potential new procedures (Jeannie)
 - a. Infinity training: Nick has completed training, as training has been opened to SC Chairs only at this point. The project management tool is similar to Trello for those who use it. Eventually, all SC members will be introduced to Infinity.
 - b. Approval of Minutes via Basecamp: Majority of members present were in favor of implementing. **Action:** will post this meeting's minutes on Basecamp for approval so that we don't have to wait until the next scheduled meeting.
 - Record Meeting for those who cannot attend: it was determined by group consensus that there is not a critical need to record our meetings at this time.
 Members who cannot attend can read over the Minutes and stay up-to-date via Basecamp.

- 6. Working groups 2023-2024 (Nick): It is important to share and distribute the work of the section. There are a number of various working groups to consider contributing to as a member.
 - a. **Information Team** (Roxana): Social media could be more active, so would love to improve this area. We are on most-popular platforms (Facebook, X, Spotify, YouTube, etc.). Would like to prepare more content in native languages to send a message that we are able to connect multilingually.
 - b. Coaching Initiative (Jeannie): This WG is mostly active around WLIC time, as it hosts an open session that provides coachees an opportunity to address a work issue or challenge with an assigned coach. At WLIC 2023, over 30 participants were coached! Note that coaching involves shaping the conversation so that coachees find their own solutions. Coaching can sometimes be confused with mentoring, where an experienced person provides advice to someone who requests help. For more information, check out the Coaching initiative webpage. This initiative is a joint-project with CPDWL:
 - c. Management Skill Building (Nick): The main project is a blog that contains articles about management. This WG has a lot of potential for building the management side, as it's not always as well-represented as marketing. Josephine has been involved in the past, and agrees that the WG has a lot of potential.
 - d. Webinar and Satellite (Roxana): Romeo was also involved in planning the webinar. One of the most-interesting and fulfilling WGs. In the past, interviews were conducted by Romeo and Stephen with prominent <u>library managers</u> as part of *Oh, The Places You'll Go: Library Managers around the World*, and they are located on our <u>YouTube channel</u>. One challenge with webinars is the need to boost viewership. Also, in the past, M&M has collaborated with the Special Needs section on marketing services. A recent Satellite was with the LGBTQ SIG and held in The Hague (*The Library Is Open!*).
 - e. **Marketing Award Jury** (Nick): The IFLA PressReader Marketing Award is one of three awards presented by various IFLA standing committees. It's a lot of fun to get involved with judging marketing entries from around the world. A heavy time commitment is required in the first three months of the calendar year.
 - f. **M&M Midterm Meeting** (Roxana). We would like to hold it in person again for 2024. The last time we met in person was 2020 in Ottawa, Canada. Roxana is interested in possibly hosting in Lima for 2024. **Action**: Chair will send out a call for proposals to see if there is any other interest in hosting.
 - g. M&M Oral History Project (Jeannie): The WG will be wrapping up its work in December 2023. So far, six videos have been recorded between current/recent M&M members and significant past personalities, including several founding members of the section. The goal is to capture the oral histories that shape our past as a standing committee of IFLA for 25 years.
 - h. Ideas/wishes from SC members for additional activities (Nick)

- i. Please speak up if there is a project or working group that you would like to contribute to. **Action**: Chair will send out a list and members can sign up for one or more groups they are interested in.
- 7. Starting up planning for the M&M midterm meeting (February '24) (Roxana)
 - a. The Lima libraries would be pleased to have M&M members visit to discover management and marketing initiatives that are happening in the region, and to grant access to several South American libraries.
