Output description

We hope to achieve the following outputs:

- A document/webpage that describes open science efforts ("snapshots") by country as seen through the eyes of our committee members (first) and other volunteers (as needed/recruited). These will provide insights for libraries wishing to integrate open science into main library functions (management, organization, services, among others) and provide a roadmap for how libraries could perform open science actions from the practice of librarianship.
- A virtual event, likely during Open Access Week 2024, that features a "global open science conversation" that builds on the country snapshots and roadmap described above.
