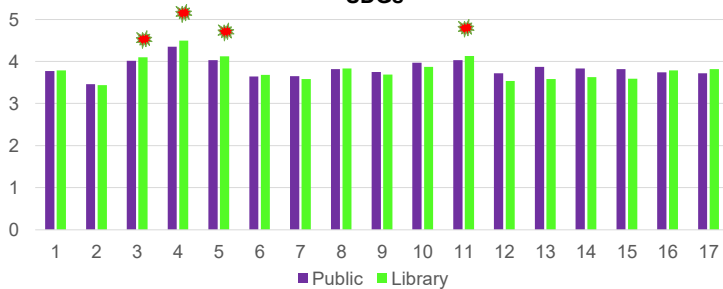

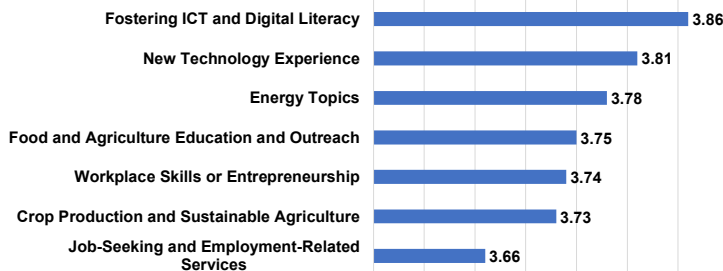

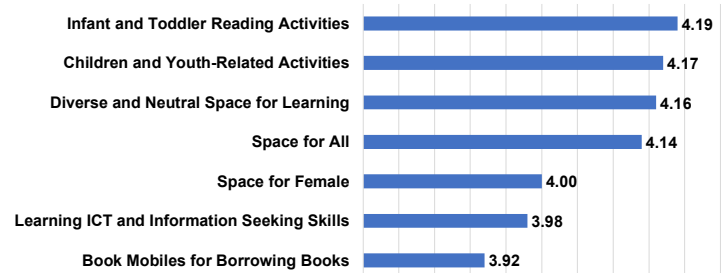
How Public and PL Perceive the Contribution of PL to SDGs



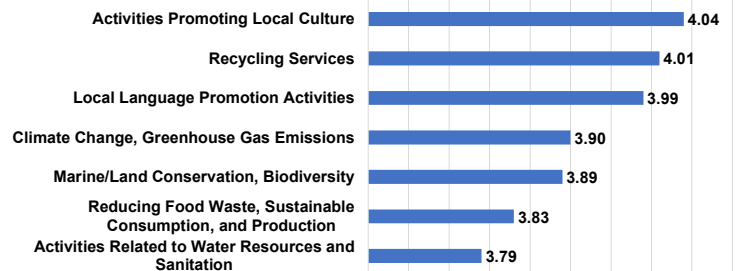
